

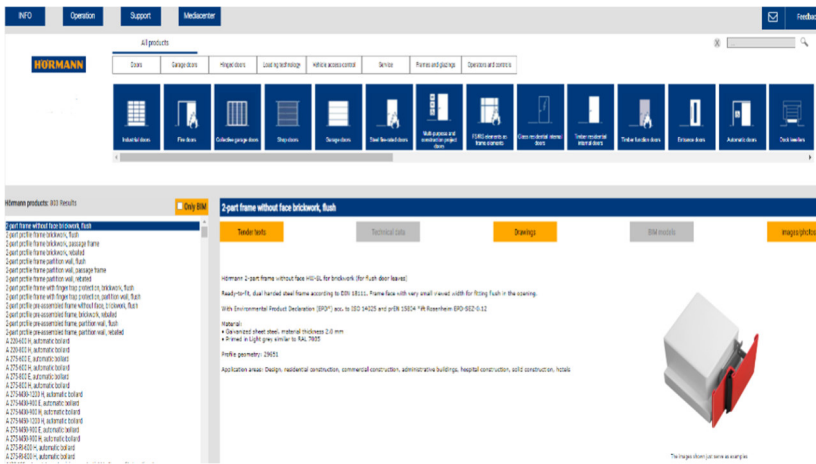

Launching the program

After launching the architects' program, the main menu opens. It gives you several options for product selection. The buttons highlighted in orange at the bottom right show the available information per product.

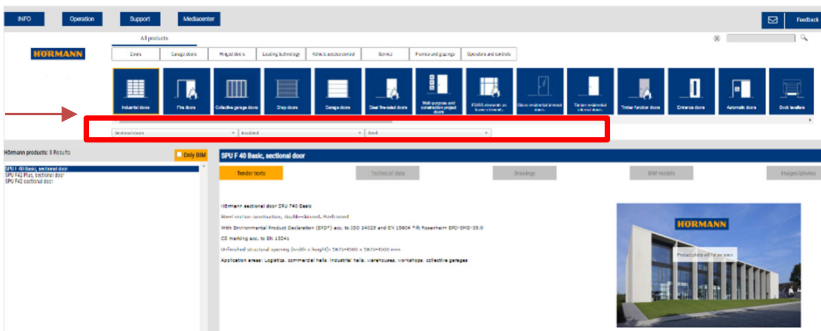


Selection options

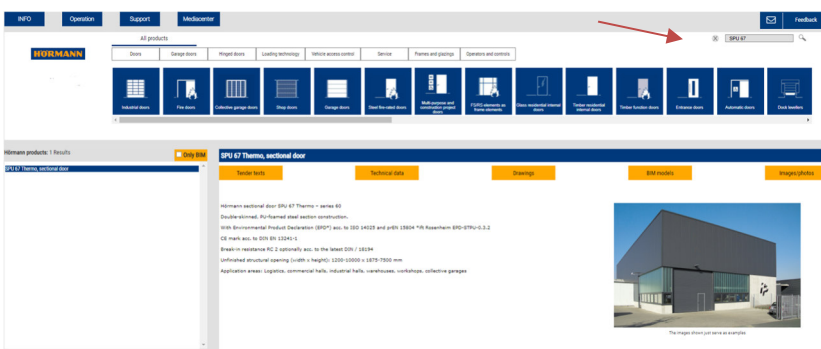
- a. Use the preselection of the project type to display the relevant product groups and then narrow down your selection via the tiles.
- b. If the product type is already known, the product can be directly selected from the list on the bottom left.
- c. As a third option you can use the search field.

Initial state:

Clicking on "All products" or the Hörmann logo always returns you to the initial state of the application.

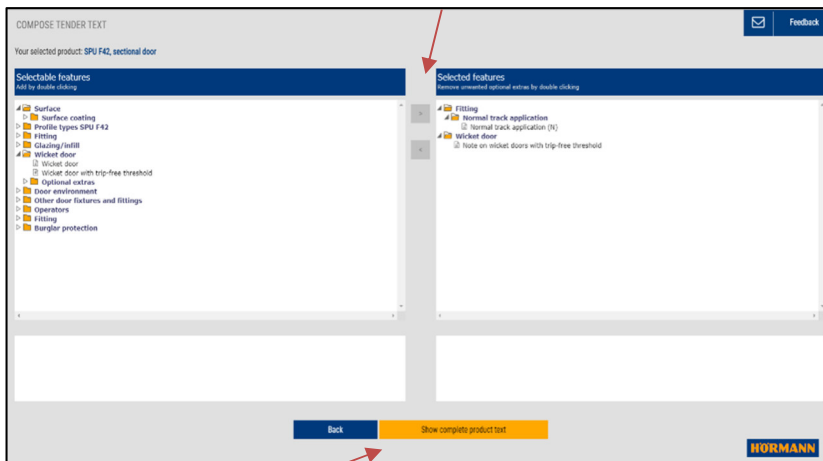


- a. After selecting the product group via the pictogram, you can limit your search further by selecting the attributes in the drop-down menus.



- c. The search field on the top right is a further option for finding the product. This searches the entire product text. You can not only enter the product name but also key words such as "fire-proof", for example.

Tender texts



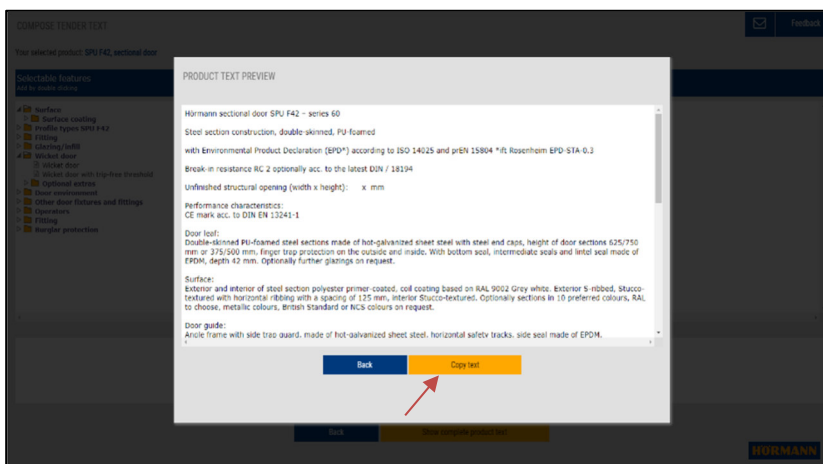
Selecting “Tender texts” takes you to the text level of the selected product. In the right window you can see the pre-set standard version that you can alter or complement as you wish.

Example: If the SPU F42 should be equipped with “normal track application with inclination (ND)”, then the “normal track application (N)” that is shown on the right should be removed by double clicking or using the arrows and the “normal track application with inclination (ND)” should be inserted from the left window by double clicking or using the arrows.

Once the product is configured according to your wishes, the text can be viewed in a separate preview window and copied to the clipboard.

Show complete product text

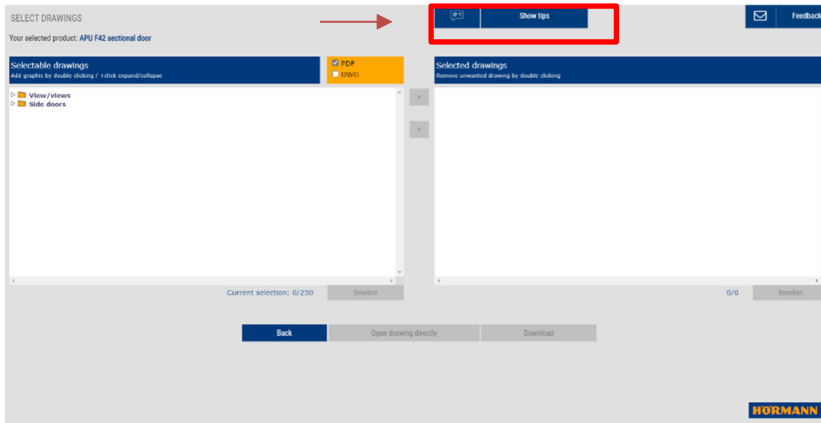
The “Show complete product text” button takes you to the preview window.



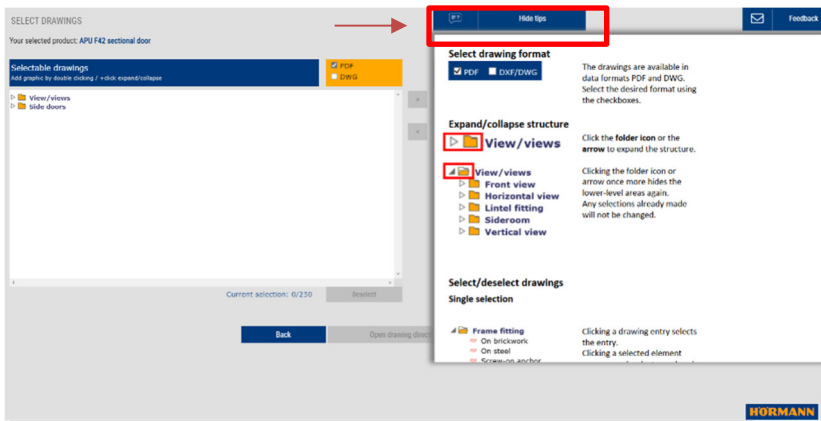
The entire product text can be checked here.

The “Copy text” button is located at the bottom right edge of the window. Selecting this button allows you to copy the entire text to the clipboard for further processing in other programs.

Show / hide tips

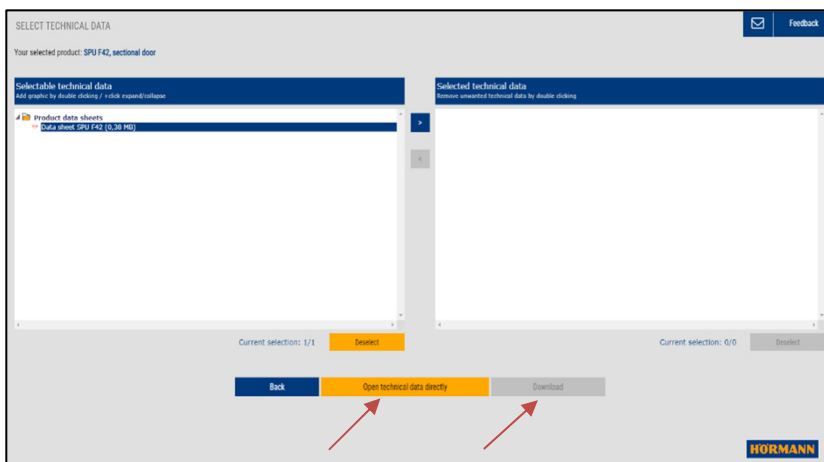


If you have selected the “Technical data” or “Drawings” level, you can open the operating instructions for the folder functions by clicking the “Show tips” button at the top edge of the window.



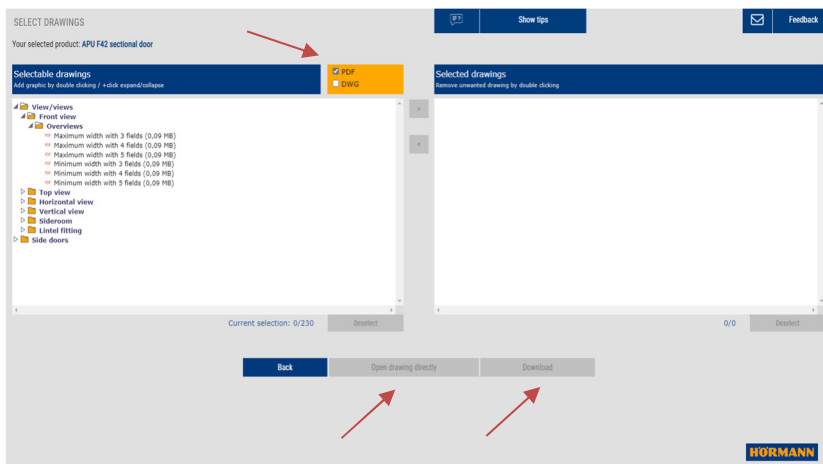
Clicking the “Show tips” button opens a field with information for operating the folder structure on the right side. While this page is shown, you can continue to operate the program and select files without the window closing. You can hide the tips either by clicking the “Hide tips” button or by clicking the X in the top right corner.

Technical data

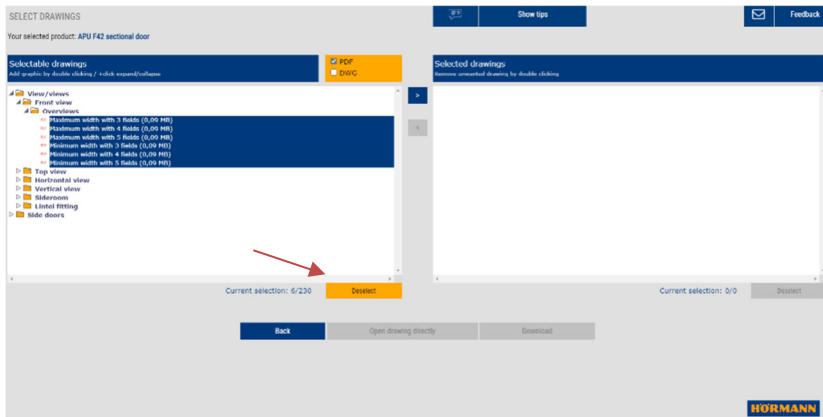


Selecting the “Technical data” level will take you to the screen shown here. You can either open the selected document directly via the button or combine several documents by double clicking or using the arrow buttons and then save them together by clicking on “Download”.

Drawings

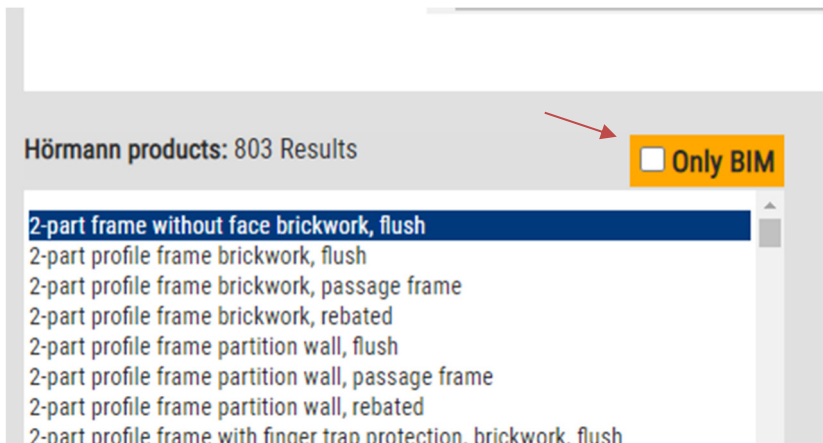


Selecting “Drawings” will take you to the screen shown here. Here, too, the selectable files are listed for the categories. The pdf or dwg format is shown by the respective symbols. If required, you can hide or show a format via the selection menu by setting a checkmark. You can either open the selected drawing directly via the button or combine several drawings by double clicking or using the arrow buttons and then save them together by clicking on “Download”.

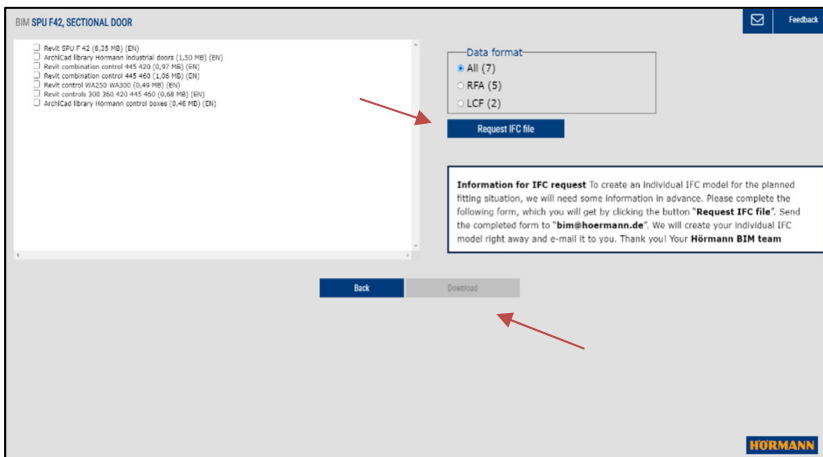


Click the level header to select all drawings below this level at once and add them to your selection using the arrow button. Click “Deselect”, which you will find below the button, to undo this selection.

BIM models

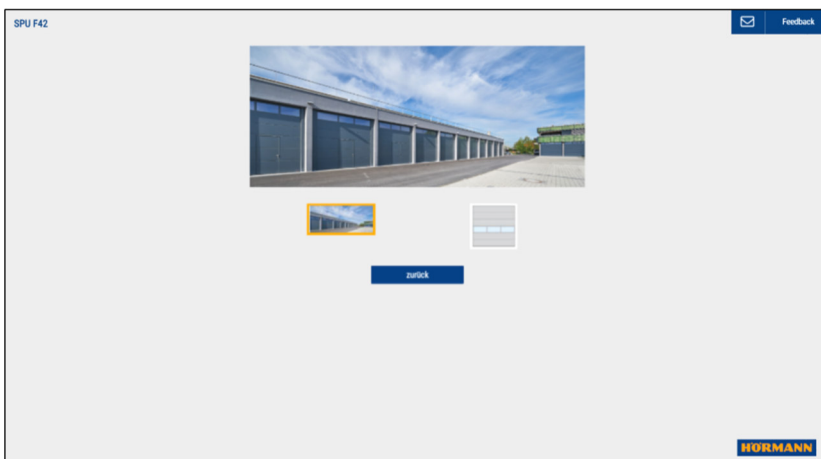


Set the checkmark for “Only BIM” to find products with BIM models faster. The other selection criteria remain active.



When selecting the “BIM models” button a pop-up window appears where you can select the file format on the right-hand side. On the left-hand side you can select the desired file and click it for downloading. IFC files have to be requested and created individually. Click the “Request IFC file” button and complete the document based on your requirements. Send the completed document to bim@hoermann.de.
